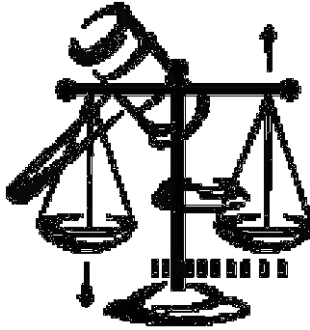


Title VI of the 1964 Civil Rights Act



The Law

Title VI of the 1964 Civil Rights Act requires that “No person in the United States shall, on the ground of race, color or national origin, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjected to discrimination under any program or activity receiving federal financial assistance.”

Applicability

Title VI covers all agencies receiving federal funds. Title VI applies to discrimination throughout an agency (Tri County Community Action Program Inc.) and Tri County CAP Transit. Title VI applies to paid staff, volunteers, clients and passengers of individual programs under an agency and the agency itself.

Filing a complaint

Title VI complaints involving recipients and beneficiaries may be filed with Tri County CAP Transit by an individual, a class, or by a third party, within 90 days from the date of the alleged discriminatory act. It shall be the policy of Tri County CAP Transit to not discriminate against an individual based upon that person’s race, color, disability or national origin. This policy applies to applicants for employment, current employees, volunteers as well as passengers, subrecipients and subcontractors of Tri County CAP Transit.
